On April 17, 2018, PacifiCorp Idaho Industrial Customers (PIIC) and Monsanto Company (Monsanto) petitioned to intervene in this case. PIIC's and Monsanto's petitions waived service for all filings not relevant to PacifiCorp.

On April 20, 2018, Idaho Irrigation Pumper's Association (IIPA) also petitioned to intervene. No one opposed IIPA's petition.

## **FINDINGS**

Commission Order 33991 set a March 6, 2018 deadline for petitions to intervene. PIIC's, Monsanto's, and IIPA's petitions are, therefore, untimely.

Untimely petitions to intervene are governed by Rules 71-75, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075. Based on the record, we find that PIIC, Monsanto, and IIPA have shown good cause for untimely filing, and that they have a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding and will not unduly broaden the issues. We thus find it reasonable to grant PIIC's, Monsanto's, and IIPA's petitions to intervene on the condition that they not delay, disrupt, or unduly broaden the issues in this proceeding. We note that, per Rule 73, PIIC, Monsanto and IIPA are bound by all prior orders and notices issued in the case.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by PIIC is granted on the conditions specified above.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by Monsanto is granted on the conditions specified above.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by IIPA is granted on the conditions specified above.
