NEWS RELEASE: Written comments being accepted on water utility proposed rate increase

BOISE (June 28, 2023) – The Idaho Public Utilities Commission is taking written comments until mid-October on an application from Algoma Water System to raise rates for residential and commercial customers.

Algoma Water serves customers in Sagle. It is asking for approval to increase residential customer rates to \$54.00 per month and increase commercial customer rates to \$89.00 per month. The commission can approve, deny or modify the proposed increase.

Comments are being accepted until Oct. 18, 2023, and are required to be filed through the commission's website or by e-mail unless computer access is not available.
