ACN plans to offer local exchange services primarily by unbundled network element platform (UNE-P) purchased through interconnection agreements with incumbent local exchange carriers. ACN proposes to begin offering local services immediately upon certification and approval of an interconnection agreement by the Commission.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the local services ACN proposes to offer will be an adjunct to the long-distance services the Company already offers in Idaho, and will include local exchange service and selected customer calling features. The Company also ensures customer access to emergency services such as 911/E911, operator services and directory assistance.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Application states that ACN has reviewed all Commission rules and agrees to comply with rules except to the extent the rules are waived for ACN or for all carriers in the same class. The Company requests exemption from the following rules:
