2. During the calendar year 2001, Albion made certain investments that constitute "qualified broadband equipment" within the meaning of Section 63-3029(I)(3)(b), Idaho Code. Broadband Services offered: ATC offers ADSL, IDSL, HDSL and SDSL services to our customers.

Network description: Over the past several years ATC has been installing equipment and engineering projects with the sole purpose in mind to make available to our customers broadband connectivity. We have deployed fiber in the loop, installed Digital Loop Carrier systems with 12,000 foot loops and are developing a fiber backbone that will have the ability to handle huge amounts of data. ATC is currently using Fujitsu fiber terminals for our backhaul and several brands of Digital Loop Carriers including AFC (Advanced Fiber Comminications) and Infinitec.
