On August 16, 2019, Birch Communications, LLC ("Company") notified the Commission that the Company changed its name to Fusion Cloud Services, LLC. The Company provides local telecommunications services, including basic local and long distance, services within Idaho under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") No. 522. The Company has asked the Commission to update all Commission records, effective as of August 26, 2019, to reflect this change. With this Order, we grant the Company's request.

BACKGROUND

On February 23, 2018, the Commission issued CPCN No. 522 to Birch Communications, LLC. Order No. 33995. The Company has now notified the Commission that it changed its name to Fusion Cloud Services, LLC. The Company filed a copy of the Amendment of Foreign Registration Statement with the Idaho Secretary of State's office on July 17, 2019. Staff reviewed the Company's Application and supporting documentation and recommended that the Commission amend Certificate No. 522 to reflect the name change to Fusion Cloud Services, LLC.

FINDINGS

Based on our review of the Company's filing and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds it appropriate to amend Certificate No. 522 to reflect that the Company has changed its name to Cloud Fusion Services, LLC.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Certificate No. 522 is amended to reflect that the Certificate holder's name is Cloud Fusion Services, LLC.

THIS IS A FINAL ORDER. Any person interested in this Order may petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of the service date of this Order with regard to any matter decided in this Order in Case No. BIR-T-18-01. Within seven (7) days after any person has petitioned for reconsideration, any other person may cross-petition for reconsideration. See *Idaho Code* §§ 61-626 and 62-619.


