On November 1, 2012, Budget Prepay, Inc. dba Budget Mobile filed two Motions pursuant to Rule 43 and Bar Commission Rule 227, for Limited Admission Pro Hac Vice for and on behalf of its attorneys: Thorvald A. Nelson and Sara K. Rundell. The Motions were signed and attested to by Budget Prepay's local counsel, Pamela Howland of the firm Holland & Hart, LLP in Boise.

In their respective Motions, Mr. Nelson and Ms. Rundell certify that they are active members in good standing of the Bar of Colorado and they maintain regular practices of law as attorneys with Holland & Hart in Greenwood Village and Denver, respectively. In addition, Mr. Nelson is also a member of the Montana Bar. They further declare they are not residents of the State of Idaho or licensed to practice law in Idaho.
