Cambridge Telephone Company, Inc. ("Cambridge"), by and through its attorneys Givens Pursley LLP, files this Application for an Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") Order certifying that certain telecommunications equipment is eligible for the broadband infrastructure tax credit authorized by Section 63-3029, Idaho Code. In support of its Application, Cambridge states as follows:

1. Cambridge is an incumbent local exchange carrier that provides both basic local exchange and advanced telecommunications services to its customer/patrons in Adams and Washington Counties, Idaho.

2. During the calendar year 2002, Cambridge made certain investments that constitute "qualified broadband equipment" within the meaning of Section 63-3029(I)(3)(b), Idaho Code. Exhibit A, attached hereto, describes Cambridge's qualified broadband equipment and contains the information and representations required by this Commission's Order No. 28784 in Case No. GNR-T-01-10.
