On February 26, 2026, Crown Castle Fiber LLC ("CCF"), Crown Castle Operating Company ("CCOC"), and Small Cells HoldCo Inc. ("Small Cells") (collectively, the "Parties"), jointly provided Notice to the Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") of the transfer of control of CCF, a wholly owned indirect subsidiary of CCOC, to Small Cells ("Notice"). Notice at 1.

At the Commission's Decision Meeting on September 8, 2026, Commission Staff ("Staff") presented a Decision Memorandum recommending the Commission acknowledge the Notice submitted by the Parties.

Having reviewed the record, we acknowledge the Notice filed by the Parties informing the Commission of the transfer of control of CCF from CCOC to Small Cells. Staff shall update Commission records with a copy of this Order and, to the extent necessary, any price lists or tariffs the Parties have on file shall be updated to reflect the transfer of control.

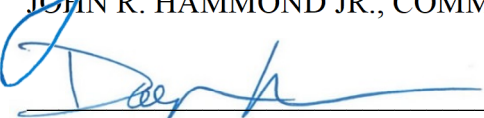

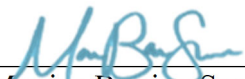
