On August 26, 2024, Aspen Creek Water Co. Inc, (“Company”) applied for authority to increase its rates and non-recurring charges. The Company seeks to increase the rate for water service to \$134.00 per month. The Company included Exhibits 1-4 to support its Application. On September 4, 2024, the Company filed additional documents that are required for a rate case. The Company requested that new rates become effective May 1, 2025.

On January 9, 2025, the Commission issued a Notice of Customer Hearing, setting a March 13, 2025, hearing date to take customer testimony in this case. Order No. 36440.

The Commission now issues this Modified Notice of Customer Hearing vacating the March 13, 2025, hearing date, and establishing a March 26, 2025, hearing date to take customer testimony in this case.


ORDER



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
