Idaho


This Certificate is for such purpose to own, hold, construct or otherwise acquire and to maintain and operate within said territory water wells, reservoirs, tanks, towers, stand pipes, collectors, settling basins, galleries and other works and structures, and also to lay, take up, repair, remove, extend, alter, maintain and operate water mains, pipes, conduits, hydrants and other appliances, equipment and facilities in, upon, over, under, along, through and across all streets, avenues, alleys, streams, highways, roads and other public places in said territory as the same now exists or may hereafter be extended, laid out or established, and to exercise the right and privileges granted, or to which may hereafter be granted Bar Circle "S" Ranch, Inc., its successors or assigns, by any franchise conferred by the State of Idaho or any political subdivision thereof.

This amended Certificate is predicated upon and issued pursuant to the findings and conclusions of Order No. 29696 in Case No. BCS-W-04-1 to which reference is hereby made.


