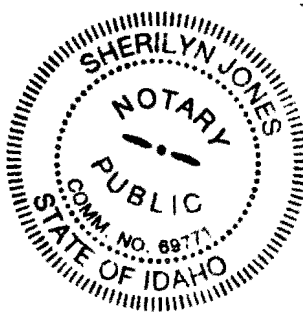

The Kootenai Heights Water System has filed an application with the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (IPUC) requesting approval of a rate increase to be effective May 1, 2023. The Commission has delayed the effective date to 30 days plus five months from this date or until the Commission has time to issue a final order. The Company is proposing to increase overall revenue by \$2452.30. (Note: The overall revenue increase = total amount collected under current rates minus total amount collected under proposed rates.) This represents an overall increase of 49.74%.

This increase is needed to pay for increased operation and maintenance costs.

If approved, a residential customer would see the monthly bill increase from \$38.50 to \$57.65, an increase of \$19.15 per month or approximately 50 percent.

This application is a proposal, subject to public review and a

Commission decision. A copy of the application is available for review at the offices of the Commission and Water Systems Management.
