Dear Mr. Black:

On May 26, 2021, North Star Water LLC (“North Star” or “Company”) applied for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to provide water-related services as a public utility in Idaho. The Company also requested that the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) set rates for the water services the Company seeks to deliver to the public.

On April 22, 2022, the Commission issued Final Order No. 35323 granting the Company a CPCN and setting rates and terms for the water services. As part of Order No. 35323, the Company was ordered to “submit tariffs conforming to this Order, as well as a sample bill and sample disconnection notice, no later than 30 days after the service date of this Order.” Order No. 35323 at 11. As of the date of this letter, the Company has failed to submit any of the documentation required by the Commission’s order.

As discussed during the meeting on July 12, 2022, because Order No. 35323 is a Final Order, the Company must comply with the Order before the Company may submit any additional motion or petition with respect to any change to the Company’s rate structure.

Please submit the required documentation within **21 days** from the receipt of this letter. Failure to submit the required documentation may result in revocation of the Company’s CPCN, monetary civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code sections 61-706 and 61-707, or any other action deemed appropriate by the Commission.
