





#### By-Laws

Of

Farko Water System

#### Article I

#### Name and Location

Section 1. The name of this Association is Farko Water.

<u>Section2.</u> The governing body of this Association shall be known as the Farko Water Board referred to herein as *the board*.

<u>Section 3.</u> The principal place of business of this Association shall be at PO BOX 826 Sagle Id.83860. The Association may, however, maintain offices and places of business at such other places within the State of Idaho as the board may determine.

#### Article II

#### Fiscal Year

The fiscal year of Farko Water shall begin the first day of June of each year.

#### Article III

#### Members

<u>Section1.</u> The holders of membership certificates of this Association are its members. Each membership certificate is equivalent to one vote in the affairs of the Association. Each membership certificate pertains to one individual property parcel and its associated drinking water connection. The number of household members does not affect voting rights in the affairs of the Farko Water. One drinking water connection is equal to one membership certificate.

<u>Section 2.</u> When a member sells or disposes of any tract within the system, his/her membership for said tract shall cease and shall be automatically transferred as herein provided to the new homeowner or property owner.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Secretary shall keep a record of the changes of title of all tracts within the boundaries of this Association, so far as possible, and upon the sale or conveyance in any manner of a member's tract, the Secretary shall create a new membership certificate and it shall be delivered to the person to whom the property is conveyed, who automatically becomes the owner thereof upon the purchase or securing a conveyance of the land.

In the event that the Secretary or board fails to issue a new membership certificate, yet the conveyance of land and household in connection to the Farko Water has transferred ownership in legal manner, the new property owner will nonetheless possess ownership of one membership certificate and voting right in regard to the governing affairs of the Association.

A transfer fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) shall be changed on each transfer. This transfer fee will be paid by the new homeowner/property owner to the Farko Water Association. The Association shall not be required to transfer any membership or provide any membership certificates until all fees, including original hookup fee, transfer or ownership fee, and all monthly service fees, are paid in full.

#### Article IV

#### Membership Certificates

<u>Section 1.</u> This Association shall not have capital stock. Its members shall be represented by membership certificates which shall be recorded, and the records shall always remain with the Secretary of Farko Water (at the Association offices).

#### Article V

#### Association Member Meetings and Elections

<u>Section 1.</u> The board of Farko Water shall meet quarterly at address (to be announced) and time. Time and place of these meetings is subject to change at the board's discretion.

<u>Section 2</u>. All-member meetings of Farko water shall occur quarterly/annually at address and time. Notice must be mailed to all members one month in advance of quarterly/annual all-member meetings. Association business, including financial records, profits, debts and liabilities must be shared at all-member meetings. Written copies of annual financial statements must also be mailed to each member.

Section 3. Special meetings of the members of the Association may be called at any time by the Chairman, or upon written petition to the Chairman, signed by ten percent (10%) of the members of the Association. The purpose of every special meeting shall be stated in the notice thereof, and no business shall be transacted at said special meeting except such as is specified in the notice.

<u>Section 4.</u> The members present at any meeting of the members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The voting powers of the members of this Association shall be equal; each member shall have one vote for each membership certificate he/she/ may hold, and the members shall be entitled to vote in person or by proxy.

<u>Section 5.</u> The board of this Association shall be elected at the all-member meeting on the third Sunday in April and board members shall take office on the first of May.

<u>Section 6.</u> The order of business at Association meetings and so far as possible at all other meetings shall be conducted by Robert's Rules of Order, Current Edition.

#### Article VI

#### Governing Body

Section 1. The board of this Association shall consist of five (5) regular members and two (2) alternates who shall make every attempt to attend all meetings. Only holders of member certificates of the Farko Water shall be eligible board members. All members will receive a letter in February to see if they want to be a nominee on the board. Nominations shall be at the April meeting with ballots mailed to certificate holders by the 1<sup>st</sup> of March and returned to the board by mail or delivered by 7:00 p.m. of the night of the March meeting. At the May meeting of the members, five directors and two alternates shall be elected for a term of one year. Elections shall be held annually thereafter. The board shall serve until their successors are elected and have qualified.

Section 2. The board shall meet within ten (10) days after election and shall elect a Chairman, Vice- Chairman, Secretary and a Treasurer from among themselves, each of whom shall hold office until the term is up unless removed by death, resignation or for cause.

Section 3. Any vacancy in the board, other than from the expiration of a term of office, shall be filled by appointment by the remaining members of the board until the next election of the members of the Association. The disqualification of a board member as a member of the Association shall operate to disqualify him/her as a board member and to create a vacancy in the office of the board.

Section 4. A majority of the board members shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the board.

<u>Section 5.</u> A board member cannot miss more than 5 consecutive meetings or that board member will be immediately removed from office. All board members that are going to miss a meeting need to notify the Secretary beforehand. When possible the board member that is missing needs to attend the meeting via teleconference.

#### Article VII

#### Duties of the Board

<u>Section 1.</u> The board, subject to restrictions of law or these By-Laws shall exercise all of the powers of the Association and, without prejudice to or limitations upon their general powers, it is hereby expressly provided that the board shall have, and are hereby given, full power and authority in respect to the matters and as hereinafter set forth:

- A. To pass upon the qualifications of members, as set forth in the above and to cause to be issued appropriate certificates of membership and cause the same to be recorded.
- B. To enter into any contracts necessary to maintain the routine distribution of safe, potable water to the members of this Association in accordance with the Idaho Administrative Code for Public Water Systems, or IDAPA 58.01.08, and as required by the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality.
- C. To select and appoint all officers, agents or employees of the Association, or remove any officers, agents or employees of the Association for just cause, prescribe such duties and designate such powers as are consistent with these By-Laws.
- D. To borrow from any source money, goods, or services, and to make and issue notes and other negotiable and transferrable instruments, mortgages, deeds of trust and trust agreements, and to do every act and thing necessary to effectuate the same.
- E. To prescribe, adopt and amend, from time to time, such equitable uniform rules and regulations as, in their discretion, may be deemed essential or convenient for the conduct of the business and affairs of the Association and the guidance and control of its officers and employees, and to prescribe adequate penalties for the breach thereof.
- F. A review of the books and accounts will be performed quarterly by the board. A full audit will be performed annually and should be budgeted for accordingly.
- G. To levy assessments against the members of the Association and to enforce the collection of such assessments by the suspension of services for the period of time the assessments are not paid. If necessary the board may impose a lien on the defaulting member for non-payment, provided, however, that services shall be promptly resumed and any lien shall be removed within three (3) days of the satisfaction of the indebtedness.
- H. Non-payment for 60 days after due date specified on bill: member will start accruing late fees at the rate of \$20 per month of delinquent payment.
- I. Non-payment for 90 days after due date: member will start accruing a 12% interest rate every month after until account is paid in full.
- J. Non-payment for one hundred twenty (120) days after due date: water will be shut off at the delinquent member's property and the bill, including late charges, will be sent to a collection agency. Member will be charged a shut off fee of \$100. To start receiving services once again, bill must be paid in full and/or a reconnection fee of \$2500. (which ever is less) a \$250. turn on fee must be paid. All accumulated charges must be paid before said member is again entitled to water services and benefits.
- K. To impose a lien on defaulting members.
- L. The board shall pass any reasonable rule to carry these provisions into effect.
- M. All fees are at the board's discretion and can be changed at any meeting of the board by a majority vote.

N. To always sufficient to pay all operation, maintaining expenses, reserve to pay indebtedness, interest and a reasonable sum as surplus fund, and to enforce these rules by refusing to furnish water or by other proper means.

#### Article VIII

#### **Duties of Officers**

Section 1. Duties of the Chairman: The Chairman shall preside over all meetings of the members and board, call special meetings of the members and board, perform all acts and duties usually performed by an executive and presiding officer, and sign all membership certificates and such other papers of the Association as he/she may be authorized or directed to sign by the board. The Chairman may call special meetings of the Association at any time and does not require the 10% member requirement mentioned in Article V section 2. The Chairman shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the board. The Chairman shall make all reports required by law to stay a corporation in good standing with the Idaho Secretary of State. Upon resignation or change of office the Chairman will return all books, records, membership certificates, and other property belonging to the Association that may be in his or her possession to the Association offices or the successor of the position.

<u>Section 2. Duties of the Vice-Chairman:</u> In the absence or disability of the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman shall perform the duties of the Chairman, provided, however, that in case of death the Association members shall elect a successor.

The Vice-Chairman shall make all reports required by law and shall perform such other duties as may be required to maintain a corporation in good standing with the Idaho Secretary of State. Upon resignation or change of office the Chairman will return all books, records, membership certificates, and other property belonging to the Association that may be in his or her possession to the Association offices or the successor of the position. The Vice-Chairman will perform all other duties as agreed upon by the board by a majority vote.

Section 3. Duties of the Treasurer: The Treasurer shall have general charge and supervision of the financial records of the Association. The Treasurer shall preside over the revenue and expenses of the Association and shall prepared and furnish the financial statements for Association members and board to review. The Treasurer shall make all financial reports required by law and shall perform such other duties as may be assigned by the board. Upon resignation or change of office the Treasurer will return all books, records, and other property belonging to the Association that may be in his or her possession to the Association offices or the successor of the position.

Section 4. Duties of the Secretary: The Secretary shall keep a complete record of all meetings of the Association and of the board. The Secretary shall sign all membership certificates with

the Chairman and such other papers pertaining to the Association as he/she may be authorized or directed to do so by the board. The Secretary shall serve all notices required by law and by these By-Laws and shall make a full report of all matters and business pertaining to his/her office to the members at the monthly meeting. The Secretary shall keep the membership certificate records of the Association and complete and countersign all certificates issued. The Secretary shall keep a membership certificate record that includes the name of each member of the Association and date of issuance, surrender, and cancellation of forfeiture.

Upon resignation or change of office the Secretary will return all books, records, membership certificates, and other property belonging to the Association that may be in his or her possession to the Association offices or the successor of the position.

Section 5. Duties of Board Member: The fifth member of the board will be responsible for keeping the water system operational. This will include obtaining updates or reports from the Idaho Licensed Water Operator regarding the functionality of the water system and associated infrastructure, water quality and water samples, longevity of infrastructure and parts, new connections and disconnected services, changes to Idaho rules for public water systems, communication with the Department of Environmental Quality, and anything else pertaining to the safe and legal operation of a public water system. This information will be shared with the members and board of Farko Water. Upon resignation or change of office the Board Member will return all books, records, membership certificates, and other property belonging to the Association that may be in his or her possession to the Association offices or the successor of the position.

Section 6. Duties of the Board: The Board of Farko water is bound and obligated to provide safe, potable water to its members at all times. The board will take measures to ensure members do not go without water at any time and will enter into contracts with outside businesses in order to do. The board is obligated to use member fees to pay for the services of an Idaho Licensed Water Operator in accordance with Idaho Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems. An Idaho Licensed Water Operator shall be employed by Farko Water at all times for the purpose of supplying potable water to each property owner and to remain in compliance with the Department of Environmental Quality regulations regarding such.

#### Article IX

#### Benefits and Duties of Members

Section1. The Association will install, maintain and/or operate a distribution pipeline that conveys potable water to the property line of each member of the Association. The point at which the distribution pipeline meets each individually owned property shall be designated the "delivery point." At each delivery point meters may be installed. The meters will be owned and maintained by the Association. The cost of the service line from the main

distribution pipeline of the Association to the property line of each member shall be paid by the Association. The Association\* will also purchase and install a lock out (referred to as cutoff valve) and cut-off valve in each service line from its main distribution line. Each cut-off valve will owned and maintained by the Farko Water, (at no time is anyone other than Farko Water control operator to touch cut-off valve) and will be installed on some portion of the service line owned by the Farko Water. The Farko water shall have the sole and exclusive right to access such cut-off valve and to turn it on or off. Back flow prevention devices will be installed at time of new hook up, \*Any new hook up cost, will be paid by new owner as hook up fee, this is above and beyond all other fees paid to hook up Farko Water System.

All extensions of the main water lines of the existing water system may be done only upon approval of a qualified engineer. The extension, if any, so approved, must be paid for completely (including engineering cost) by the persons desiring the extensions to service their tracts. Any extension, if approved and paid for, shall become the property of the Farko Water and must be installed and constructed under the Farko Water's control, management and supervision, and shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the Farko Water and its By-Laws.

Section 2. Each member should be entitled to one only service line from the Association's water system to each residence owned by such member. The member shall be required to pay a fee, set by the board, for such service line. No new service line or change in an existing service line may be made which will interfere with an existing service line or the delivery of water therein. Each service line shall connect the property served with the Farko Water's distribution pipeline at the nearest available place for use by the member and shall be of sufficient capacity to permit the delivery of water through a service line at that place within the system without interfering with the delivery of water through a prior service line, (Only Farko Water control operator can service any water line). A person may own more than property and as such have more than one certificate. If the Farko Water's water supply is inadequate to permit the delivery of water without interfering with the delivery of water through a prior service line, then a new service line shall be installed at such place as may be designated by the Farko Water and as approved by a qualified professional. Each new member will be required to get permission from Farko Water to dig, or have dug, a ditch for the purpose of connecting the distribution pipeline, at the delivery point, to the member's dwelling and will be required to purchase that portion of the service line (and to pay for installation) of line to be installed for service connection. The Farko Water shall not own nor maintain any part of the distribution piping or plumbing that is found on individual property parcels nor which exists after the delivery point of each service connection. Customer must notify Farko Water of any leaks on the owners property or any part of Farko Water pipes, valves, etc. asap as to limit damages to Farko Water system. Failure to notify will result in a \$1500. Fine.

Section 3. Each member shall be entitled to purchase from the Farko Water, pursuant to such agreements as may from time to time be provided and required by the Farko Water, such water for domestic purposes, \*including livestock and irrigation of property(see section 4), as a member may desire, subject, however, to the provisions of these By-Laws and to such rules and (along with drought condition requirements) as well as regulations as may be prescribed by the board. Each member shall be entitled to have delivered to him/her such water as through the service line may be metered and the charges for such water shall be determined separately. \* Any and all watering must be kept to a minimum and at no time will water be allowed to run uncontrolled or dripping into a tank or other water holding container. At no time shall a customer supply water to a disconnected property, resulting violation will incur \$1500. fine and possible disconnection from Farko water system

Section 4. In the event the total water capacity of the Farko Water shall be insufficient to meet all of the needs of the members or in the event there is a shortage of water, the board may prorate the water available among the various members on such a basis as is deemed equitable by the board. The board may also prescribe a schedule of water use for garden or irrigation purposes as needed and shall require adherence thereto, or they may prohibit the use of water for non-essential services such as gardening and irrigation. Such means shall be employed during any time the total water supply is insufficient to equitably meet the needs of all members for daily necessities. The Farko Water must first satisfy the needs of all members for domestic purposes before supplying any water for livestock purposes and must satisfy the needs of all members for domestic and livestock purposes before supplying water for sprinkling or garden purposes.

Section 5. The board shall, as soon as practical after the ending of each fiscal year, determine the monthly cost to be charged to each member during the following fiscal year for potable water service. Monthly cost (which will be a set rate for all connection, no split level billing will occur,) of service will be assessed per water connection irrespective of whether any water is used by a member during any month. Monthly billing statements shall be mailed to all members of Farko Water at address of record.(It is up to member to keep Farko Water notified of current billing address). Clear payment date, instructions for payment submittal, and late fee penalties shall be communicated with each member in writing. Failure to pay monthly charges shall result in the automatic imposition of penalties as specified in Article VII section 1.

#### Article X

#### Finances and Surplus Funds

<u>Section 1.</u> The Farko Water shall use all money collected from members for the purpose of operating, maintaining, and repairing as needed the water system and associated facilities and infrastructure. Operating fees shall include payment for contractors and other such professionals

as are needed to achieve and maintain compliance with state and federal regulations for public water systems.

<u>Section 2</u>. Any surplus funds remaining after operational costs have been paid will be held for future repairs, upgrades, or emergencies and with the understanding that lending companies will require proof of sound financial practice.

All outstanding balance will be paid by Farko Water until paid in full. This includes attorneys fees and past wages due to previous employee.\*

#### Article XI

#### **Amendments**

<u>Section1</u>. These By-Laws may be amended by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members present at any regular meeting of the Farko Water, or at any special meeting of the Farko Water called for that purpose, with the exception that the members shall not have the power to change the purpose of the Association so as to decrease its rights and powers under the laws of the State, or to waive any requirements of bond or other provisions for the safety and security of the property and funds of the Association, or to deprive any member of rights and privileges then existing, or so to amend the By-Laws as to effect a fundamental change in the policies of this Association. Notice of any amendment to be made at a special meeting of the members must be given at least ten (10) days before such meeting and must set forth the amendments to be considered.

#### Article XII

#### Severability

<u>Section 1</u>. Invalidation of any part of these By-Laws by judgment in court shall in no way affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force.

- 1.1 The Customer, in receiving water service, and the Company, in providing water service, both agree to abide by these Rules and Regulations.

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- 3.4 Special contracts may be required where large investments in special facilities are necessary to provide the requested service. The Company may require contribution toward such investment and establish such minimum charges as are deemed necessary. All such contracts are subject to the approval of the Commission.
- 3.5 The Company reserves the right to place limitations on the amount and character of water service it will supply and to refuse service to new Customers if, in its opinion:
  - (a) The Company is required to refuse or limit service by regulatory authorities having jurisdiction over the Company.
  - (b) The requested service installation is of larger size than is necessary to properly serve the premises.
  - (c) The permanency of the building, structure, or institution requested to be served is such that the Company's investment in such service is jeopardized.
  - (d) The depth of the Customer's service line is less than the minimum depth required for frost protection.
  - (e) The Customer's proposed service, main or other appurtenance does not conform to good engineering design or meet the standard specifications of the Company.

(f) The Customer refuses to agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Company.

If the Company denies service to a potential Customer for any reason, it will immediately provide the applicant with a written explanation of its decision in accordance with UCRR.

- 4. DEPOSITS
  - 4.1 Rules and Regulations regarding deposits to guarantee payment of bills can be found in Rules 101-109 UCRR.
- 5. RATES
  - 5.1 Rates charged for water service and supply shall be those published in the Company's tariff and approved by the Idaho Public Utilities Commission.
- 6. BILLING AND PAYMENT
  - 6.1 All Customers will be billed on a regular basis as identified on the applicable rate schedule.

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- 6.2 If the system is metered, the Company shall try to read the meters prior to each billing unless specified differently on the applicable rate schedule. If the Company's meter reader is unable to gain access to the premises to read the meter, or in the event the meter fails to register, the Company may estimate the Customer's water consumption for the current billing period based on known consumption for a prior similar period or average of several periods. Subsequent readings will automatically adjust for differences between estimated and actual. Estimated bills shall carry appropriate notice to that effect.
  - 6.3 All bills shall clearly indicate the balance due and shall be due and payable no less than 15 days after the date rendered. All bills not paid by due date shall be considered delinquent and service may be disconnected subject to the provisions of UCRR.
  - 6.4 The minimum bill or customer charge shall apply when service is provided for less than one month.
  - Owners of premises with one or more condominiums, buildings, stores, apartments or any other divisions of like or similar character, all of which are served from one (1) service connection are responsible for the entire water charges. If the owner desires to cease being responsible for water bills for such places and desires that the occupant of each division shall be responsible for her or her respective bill, such transfer of responsibility will not be accepted or recognized by the Company until the plumbing

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arrangements of the building or premises are so changed by the owner or his or her agent as to permit the Company, to its satisfaction, to serve each division or occupant separately from the other occupants in the same building.

Accounts will be continued and water bills rendered 6.6 regularly until the Company has been duly notified to discontinue service.

#### METERING (If Applicable) 7.

- Meters will be installed by the Company near the Customer's property line or at any other reasonable location on the Customer's premises that is mutually agreed upon.
- The Company's representative shall be given access 7.2 to the Customer's premises at all reasonable hours for the purpose of obtaining meter readings. In the event of recurring inaccessibility, the Company, at its option, may relocate its metering equipment at the Customer's expense.
- The Company is responsible for the maintenance of its 7.3 metering equipment. Meters are considered to be sufficiently accurate if tests indicate that meter accuracy is within + 2 percent. When for any reason a meter fails to register within these limits of accuracy, the Customer's use of water will be estimated on the basis of available data and charges will be adjusted accordingly. Corrected bills will then be sent out to the customer and additional payment or refund arrangements made in accordance with UCRR.

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- The Company reserves the right to test and/or replace any 7.4 meter. Upon deposit of a "Meter Testing Fee" by a Customer, the Company will test the Customer's meter. If the test indicates that the meter over-registers by more than 2 percent, it will be replaced with an accurate meter at no cost to the Customer and the "Meter Testing Fee" will be refunded and water bills will be adjusted in accordance with UCRR.
- At the Company's discretion, unmetered Customers may be 7.5 converted to metered service if such transition occurs in a planned, systematic manner without unreasonable discriminations and if the Company has an approved metered rate.
- The Company shall have the right to set meters or other 7.6 devices without notice to the Customer for the detection and prevention of fraud.
- In any building where the meter is to be installed in the 7.7 basement, the incoming water pipe must enter the basement at least sixteen (16) inches from the riser in order that a meter can be set in a horizontal position in the basement. All pipes to the different parts of the building or grounds must lead from the riser at least one (1) foot above the elbow.

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#### CUSTOMER PLUMBING AND APPLIANCES 8.

- All plumbing, piping, fixtures and appliances on the 8.1 Customer's side of the service connection shall be installed and maintained under the responsibility and at the expense of the Customer or owner of the premises.
- The plumbing, piping, fixtures and appliances shall be 8.2 maintained in conformity with all municipal, state and federal requirements. The nature and condition of this plumbing, piping and equipment shall be such as not to endanger life or property, interfere with service to other Customers or permit those with metered services to divert system water without meter registration.
- A stop-and-waste valve must be installed on the Customer's 8.3 plumbing in a place always accessible and so located as to permit shutting off the water for the entire premises with the least possible delay.
- All persons having boilers, water tanks or other equipment 8.4 supplied by direct pressure from the Company's mains should install a pressure relief valve, or other device to serve the same purpose, so as to prevent excess pressure from forcing hot water and/or steam back into the water meter and mains of the Company. All damage to the Company's property resulting from failure to properly equip Customer plumbing with a relief valve shall be billed to the Customer.

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- 8.5 The Company is not obligated to perform any service whatever in locating leaks or other trouble with the customer's piping.
- When the premises served by the Company is also served in any manner from another water supply of any kind, an approved backflow prevention device shall be installed at the service connection. Water service for either stand-by or other purposes will not be furnished until piping and connections are inspected and approved by a representative of the Company.
- 8.7 Property owners will not be allowed to connect the water service of different properties together.
- 8.8 All of the Customer's service pipes and fixtures must be kept in repair and protected from freezing at his or her expense. When there are leaking or defective pipes or fixtures, the water may be turned off at the option of the Company until the proper repairs are made.

### 9. INSTALLATION OF SERVICE CONNECTIONS

9.1 The service connection is the property of the Company and as such, the Company is responsible for its installation and maintenance. It consists of piping, curbstop and valve or meter box and a meter, if the system is metered. The service connection transmits water from the Company's water main to a valve or meter box generally located near the Customer's property line. All piping, valves or appliances beyond this point are the property and responsibility of the Customer.

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- 9.2 The Company reserves the right to designate the size and location of the service line, curbstop, meter (if applicable) and meter or valve box and the amount of space which must be left unobstructed for the installation and future maintenance and operation thereof.
- Where a service connection is desired for a premises on which there is no permanent structure, the Company will install a service connection to said premises only upon payment by the applicant of the estimated cost of said service connection. If within a period of five (5) years from the installation of said service connection a permanent structure is erected on the premises, the Company will refund, with interest, the difference between any approved new Customer charges in effect at the time of connection, and the applicant's advance.
- 9.4 The extra costs of any out-of-the-ordinary circumstances requiring additional equipment or special construction techniques involved in the installation of a service connection will be agreed to in advance by the Customer and the Company.

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#### REPLACEMENT OR ENLARGEMENT OF SERVICE CONNECTION 10.

- Unless otherwise provided herein, the Company shall 10.1 replace or enlarge service connections at its own expense, as follows:
  - Whenever it is necessary to change the location of (a) any service connection due to relocation or abandonment of the Company's mains; and
  - For commercial or industrial services where the type (b) or volume of use has changed and the enlargement will result in sufficient increase in annual revenue to justify the enlargement.
- The relocation, enlargement or reduction of service 10.2 connections for the convenience of the Customer will be at the expense of the Customer. Prior to such relocation, enlargement or reduction, the Customer will deposit the estimated cost thereof with the Company. Within fifteen (15) days a refund will be made to the Customer in the amount by which the estimated cost exceeds the actual cost. The amount by which the actual cost exceeds the estimated cost shall be due and payable within fifteen (15) days after billing for such deficiency.
- Enlargement of any service connection will be made only 10.3 after such time as the Customer's plumbing inside his or her premises shall have been enlarged sufficiently to accommodate the additional capacity.

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#### DISCONNECTION AND RECONNECTION OF SERVICE 11.

- When a Customer desires to discontinue service he shall 11.1 give notice to the Company at least two (2) days in advance and shall be responsible for all water consumed for the two (2) days after the date of such notice.
- The Company may discontinue a Customer's service on an 11.2 involuntary basis only in accordance with UCRR.
- When it becomes necessary for the Company to involuntarily 11.3 discontinue water service to a Customer, service will be reconnected only after all bills for service then due have been paid or satisfactory payment arrangements have been made.
- A reconnection fee will be charged each time a Customer is 11.4 disconnected, either voluntarily or involuntarily, and reconnected at the same premises. The reconnection fee shall be paid before service is restored. Reconnection fees will not be charged for any situation or circumstance in which the Customer's water supply is disconnected by the Company for its convenience.
- The Company reserves the right at any time, upon notice, 11.5 to shut off the water for maintenance or expansion and, in emergencies, may do so without notice. The Company shall at all times use reasonable diligence and care to prevent interruption of said water service.

#### 12. EXTENSION OF WATER MAINS

12.1 The extension of system water mains for the purpose of providing new service shall be done on a time and material basis.

#### 13. MISCELLANEOUS

- No Customer shall permit any person from another premises to take water from his or her water service or tap for more than (1) week without the written permission and consent of the Company.
- No person acting either on his or her own behalf or an agent of any person, firm, corporation or municipality, not authorized by the Company, shall take any water from any fire hydrant on the Company's system except in the case of an emergency.
- No person shall place upon or about any hydrant, gate, box, meter, meter box or other property of the Company, any building material or other substance so as to prevent free access at all times to the same.
- 13.4 Service will be maintained to domestic Customers on a preferential basis. Delivery of water under all schedules may be restricted, interrupted or curtailed at the discretion of the Company in case of shortage or threatened shortage of water.

- 13.5 No rate contract or application is assignable from one user to another, except upon agreement of all parties concerned.
- The representative of the Company shall be given access to the premises of the Customer at all reasonable hours for obtaining meter readings, for turning on or shutting off the flow of water, for inspecting, removing, repairing or protecting from abuse or fraud any of the property of the Company installed on the premises. Access shall be granted at all times for emergency purposes.
- No one, except an authorized agent of the Company, shall tamper with, interfere with, make repairs, connections or replacements of or to any of the Company's property.
- Whenever an applicant desires service of a character for which there is no available service classification, a contract may be executed in lieu of a tariff. Any such contract is subject to the approval of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission.
- The Customer is held responsible for any violation of these Rules and Regulations even though the breach is committed by someone employed either directly, or indirectly, by the customer.
- 13.10 Copies of the Company's rates and rules summary of regulations will be available at utility's office; will be provided to customers upon commencement of service; and, will be provided to customers annually in accordance with Utility Customer Relations Rules (UCRR) and Utility Customer Information Rules (UCIR).

Because you have identified yourself as the owner, or director, of Farko Water, and currently operating PTE Water, we need you to take the following steps:

- 1. File an Application with the Commission to transfer CPCN to Farko Water;
- 2. Provide documents outlining and demonstrating current legal ownership of PTE Water assets, well(s), water rights, etc.; and,
- 3. Provide Corporate documents of Farko Water, including:
  - a. Secretary of State Articles of Incorporation.

We request that the documents and information be provided in **fourteen (14) days**. Your prompt response will allow us to begin the process of transferring CPCN No. 393.

I am writing this to clarify the status of PTE, a water utility regulated by the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (IPUC). Based on the information you have provided to the staff of the IPUC to date, it appears that ownership of PTE was transferred from Robaer Cobott, President and sole owner of PTE, and Zaderea Raphael, Mr. Cobott's wife and Secretary of PTE, to you, Demetrius Kovacs. Subsequently, in December 2015, action was taken to dissolve PTE, and arrangements were made to continue providing service to customers through Farko Water System, Inc., on an interim basis.

As of this writing, the IPUC has not received an application regarding the transfer of PTE's assets (including its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity) to a successor water system. You agreed to submit an application as soon as possible. That application may include a request for an increase in water rates. The application, including any proposal to increase rates, will be subject to the Staff's review and the IPUC's approval. Customers will have the opportunity to comment on the application, including any proposed rate increase. In the interim, you agreed to continue to charge customers the existing PUC-approved rates for water service from PTE. Larry Fairfax will continue to be the System Operator and assume other duties as assigned. Billing, collection of payment, and service calls will be handled by Farko Water System.
