On January 18, 2024, an Application ("Application") was submitted to the Commission which stated that Ponderosa Terrace Estates Water System, Inc. ("PTE") was sold to Farko Water System Inc. ("Farko")¹ on October 1, 2016. While the Application's heading requested a transfer of PTE's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN"), the body of the Application clearly requested that PTE's CPCN be cancelled. Rather than ask that Farko be issued a new CPCN, the Application requested that the Commission recognize that Farko is operating the system as a not-for-profit organization; supplemental information related to this request was attached to the Application.

On February 16, 2024, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Notice of Intervention Deadline. Order No. 36093. No parties intervened.

The Commission now issues a Notice of Modified Procedure.

NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Commission has determined that the public interest may not require a formal hearing in this matter, and that it will proceed under Modified Procedure pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Procedure 201-204, IDAPA 31.01.01.201-.204. The Commission notes that Modified Procedure and written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that persons desiring to state a position on this Application may file a written comment explaining why the person supports or opposes the Application. Persons who would like a hearing must specifically request a hearing in their written comments and explain why written comments alone are insufficient. **Persons interested in filing**

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that if no written comments or protests are received within the time limit set, the Commission will consider this matter on its merits and enter its Order

without a formal hearing. If written comments are received within the time limit set, the Commission will consider them and, in its discretion, may set the same for formal hearing.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Company's Application be processed by Modified Procedure. Persons interested in submitting written comments must do so by June 12, 2024. The Company must file any reply comments by June 20, 2024.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties comply with Order No. 35375, issued April 21, 2022. Generally, all pleadings should be filed with the Commission electronically and will be deemed timely filed when received by the Commission Secretary. *See* Rule 14.02. Service between parties should continue to be accomplished electronically when possible. However, voluminous discovery-related documents may be filed and served on CD-ROM or a USB flash drive.
