Dear Mr. Bernard:

On May 25, 2022, the Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") issued Order No. 35418 in Case No. ROC-W-21-01. As part of Order No. 35418, the Commission ordered that Rocky Mountain Utility Company ("Company"):

shall take daily water pressure readings from appropriate locations on the Company's water system for 14 days, starting the day after the issuance of this Order. At the end of the 14-day water pressure testing period the Company shall submit a report to the Commission containing the daily water pressure readings within 21 days of issuance of this Order.

Order No. 35418 at 11. As of the date of this letter, the Company has failed to submit any of the documentation required by the Commission's order.

Please submit the required documentation within **21 days** from the receipt of this letter. Failure to submit the required documentation may result in monetary civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code sections 61-706 and 61-707, or any other action deemed appropriate by the Commission.
