



Dear Eagle Water Company Customer,

SUEZ filed a joint application with the Idaho Public Utilities Commission to acquire Eagle Water assets. SUEZ is thrilled at the prospect of serving more of our neighbors, and we wanted to answer some common questions.

Will my dollars stay in Idaho?

Yes, much of your money will stay in the area. Our Idaho office is staffed by more than 100 people, all of whom live in the Treasure Valley. Idahoans will read your meters, answer your calls, repair the pipes, and ensure you have safe, dependable drinking water.

Why would rates change?

Eagle Water hasn't raised its rates in decades, which isn't sustainable and doesn't support regular system upgrades. SUEZ intends to invest \$13.4 million into the Eagle Water system over the next 3 years. SUEZ needs to replace meters, upgrade generators, add critical system disinfection, ensure adequate fire protection, and improve system monitoring. The new rates requested from the Public Utilities Commission would also bring Eagle Water customers level with existing SUEZ customers. Future improvement costs will be shared by all customers.
