On February 19, 2026, Teton Water and Sewer Company, LLC ("Company") applied to the Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") requesting to revise Rate Schedule No. 2, Non-Recurring Fees and Charges ("Schedule No. 2").

On June 8, 2026, the Commission issued Order No. 37059, approving the revision to Schedule No. 2, with modifications. The Commission approved Commission Staff's ("Staff") recommended Hookup Charge of \$2,996 and recommended tariff language. Order No. 37059 at 4. The Commission ordered the Company to submit an updated tariff, including the \$2,996 Hookup Charge and revised tariff language, together with any other required documentation, as a compliance filing for Commission review and approval, within 30 days of the date of the Order. *Id.*

On June 26, 2026, the Company filed an updated tariff with the \$2,996 Hookup Charge and the revised tariff language, as a compliance filing.

During the Commission's July 23, 2026, decision meeting, Staff presented a Decision Memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the Company's tariff, as filed on June 26, 2026, with an effective date of June 8, 2026.

COMMISSION FINDINGS AND DECISION

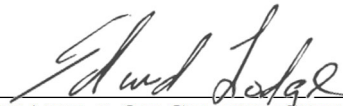
Having reviewed the Company's compliance filing, Staff's recommendations, and the record, the Commission finds that the Company has submitted the documents and other information required by Order No. 37059. We hereby approve the Company's tariff submitted on June 26, 2026, as filed, effective June 8, 2026.
