On November 22, 2024, Veolia Water Idaho, Inc., (“Company”) filed an application with the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) requesting an Order approving revisions to the Company’s schedules of rates and charges for water service in the State of Idaho.

On April 21, 2025, the Company filed an all-party Stipulation and Settlement, and a Motion to Approve Stipulation and Settlement. On May 30, 2025, the Commission issued Order No. 36624 approving the Motion and Proposed Settlement as filed with attachments and authorized the Company to implement revised tariff schedules consistent with the terms of the Proposed Settlement, effective June 1, 2025.

On June 2, 2025, the Company submitted updated tariffs to confirm the approving order number and June 1, 2025, effective date.

### COMMISSION FINDINGS AND DECISION

The Commission has jurisdiction over the Application and the issues in this case under Title 61 of the Idaho Code including *Idaho Code* §§ 61-301 through 303. The Commission is empowered to investigate rates, charges, rules, regulations, practices, and contracts of all public utilities and to determine whether they are just, reasonable, preferential, discriminatory, or in violation of any provisions of law, and to fix the same by order. *Idaho Code* §§ 61-501 through 503.

Having reviewed the record and all submitted filings, the Commission finds that the Company’s updated tariffs submitted through a compliance filing on June 2, 2025, with a June 1, 2025, effective date conform with the provisions of Order No. 36624.

### ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Company’s updated tariffs submitted in the June 2, 2025, compliance filing with a June 1, 2025, effective date are approved.

THIS IS A FINAL ORDER. Any person interested in this Order may petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of the service date upon this Order regarding any

matter decided in this Order. Within seven (7) days after any person has petitioned for reconsideration, any other person may cross-petition for reconsideration. *Idaho Code* §§ 61-626.


