


<p>A construction inspection was performed on DAS-CO, a contractor for Intermountain Gas Company.</p> <p>11 April 2018: (3 Construction) The crew was installing a new 2" plastic main line (# 425-9125) to abandon an old Aldyl A main.</p> <p>Areas observed during this project were: Other utility location, Excavation, Pot holing, Bell holing, Directional drilling, Main line installation (tracer wire), Plastic pipe joining, Pipe/Coating inspected/removed, Welding, Hot-tapping, Pigging, Pressure testing, and Backfilling.</p> <p>12 April 2018: (3 Construction) The crew was installing a new 6" Steel main line (# 283-0428) along Hwy 16 in Emmett.</p> <p>Areas observed during this project were: Crews were conducting clean-up on sections of the project that have already been completed. County officials and IGC personnel met during work stoppage stemming from an accident that occurred the night before.
