On October 22, 2010, Idaho Power filed an Application requesting that the Commission issue an Order “accepting the Company’s demand-side resources business model.” Application, p. 1. The Application seeks authorization to adjust ways for the Company to recover the costs of its energy efficiency programs. More specifically, the Company proposes to (1) move certain demand response incentive payments into the Power Cost Adjustment on a prospective basis beginning June 1, 2011; (2) establish a regulatory asset for Custom Efficiency program incentive costs beginning January 1, 2011; and (3) change the carrying charge on the Energy Efficiency Rider from the customer deposit rate to the Company’s authorized rate of return. Application, p. 1.

The parties convened a scheduling meeting on January 12, 2011, and subsequently submitted the following schedule to process the case. The Commission adopts the following schedule:


February 7, 2011	Settlement Conference, 10:00 a.m.
February 17, 2011	Staff/Intervenor Prefile Testimony
March 17, 2011	Company file Rebuttal Testimony
April 7, 2011	Hearing

In addition, those parties that believe factual issues need resolution will circulate a statement of disputed facts to all parties no less than seven days before the settlement conference. The parties have also agreed to make a good-faith effort to respond to discovery requests within 14 days.

**ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parties conform to the schedule set forth in this Procedural Order.
