2. This Intervenor, the Industrial Customers of Idaho Power, (“ICIP”) is an unincorporated association of Schedule 19 customers of Idaho Power. All ICIP members receive electric utility services from Idaho Power Company. The ICIP claims a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding in that its members’ electric rates may be affected by the outcome of this proceeding.
