On August 7, 2014, Matt Vespa filed a Motion, pursuant to Idaho Bar Commission Rule (IBCR) 227, for Pro Hac Vice Admission. The Motion was signed and attested to by local counsel Dean J. Miller of Boise, Idaho (ISB #1968).

Mr. Vespa certifies that he is an active member in good standing of the Bar of the State of California and that he maintains the regular practice of law as an attorney for Sierra Club in San Francisco. Mr. Vespa further declares that he is not a resident of the State of Idaho nor is he licensed to practice law in Idaho. Mr. Vespa states that he has never been admitted to practice under the Idaho Bar Commission Rules.

Mr. Vespa and Mr. Miller attested that a copy of the Motion has been served by electronic mail upon other parties in this matter. They further assert that a copy of the Motion, accompanied by the required \$325 fee and a certificate of good standing, have been submitted to the Idaho State Bar. Mr. Miller acknowledges that his attendance shall be required at all Commission proceedings in which Mr. Vespa appears, unless specifically excused by the Commission.

**FINDINGS**

The Commission has reviewed the Motion for Pro Hac Vice Admission filed by Matt Vespa. Staff has confirmed with the Idaho State Bar that it has received Mr. Vespa's Motion, \$325 fee and certificate of good standing. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 43 and Bar Rule 227, the Commission finds it reasonable to grant limited admission to Mr. Vespa in this matter.

**ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Matt Vespa is granted Limited Admission, Pro Hac Vice, to represent Sierra Club in this case.


