**1.1 APPLICATION OF CATALOG**

This document contains regulations, rates and charges applicable to the provision of Carrier Common Line, Switched Access Service, Expanded Interconnection Service and other miscellaneous services, hereinafter referred to collectively as service(s), provided by Qwest Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the Company. These services are provided to customers for resale of intrastate telecommunication services to others. Switched Access Services are also provided to end users who utilize Feature Group A Switched Access Service-Foreign Exchange (FX) Services or Off Network Access Lines (ONAL) connected to a private line network not for resale. A Carrier Identification Code (CIC) must be obtained before customers can purchase Switched Access Service for resale.

Providers of interexchange service, that furnish service between Local Calling Areas, must purchase services from this document for their use in furnishing their authorized intrastate telecommunications services to end user customers, and for operational purposes directly related to the furnishing of such services.

The provision of such services by the Company as set forth in this document does not constitute a joint undertaking with the customer for the furnishing of any service.
