Recommendation was made that a 2nd Well be drilled and added to the water system because of expansion of the subdivision. The Well has been drilled and was completed in February 2007. No other recommendations have been made at this time.

System Engineering Data- Line 10: Back Bone Plant Additions

A pump house for the new well is expected to be completed in 2022 at an estimated cost of \$30,000. A backup generator was installed in 2020 and an auto switch is expected to be installed in 2022. The estimated cost of the auto switch is projected to cost \$1,500. These costs will be provided by either the company or the developer.
