This confirms that Falls Water Company, Inc. has the ability, capacity, and willingness to provide domestic water utility service to the proposed development, Bridgewater Division No. 5.

Part of S 1/2 NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 2 North, Range 38 East, Boise Meridian, Bonneville County, Idaho. More particularly described as:

Commencing at the NE corner of said Section 15; Thence S 00°02'56" E. 2639.82 feet along the section line to the E 1/4 corner of said Section 15; Thence S 89°47'10" W. 1018.56 feet to the SW corner of Bridgewater Division No. 1 (Instrument No. 1229650) and the point of beginning; Thence N 89°24'18" W. 408.39 feet along said boundary line; Thence N 00°15'06" W 390.05 feet to the S boundary line of Bridgewater Division No. 4 (Instrument No. 1276998); Thence S 89°24'17" E 317.03 feet along the S boundary line of Bridgewater Divisions 3 & 4 to the NW corner of Block 1 of said Bridgewater Division No. 1; Thence S 27°23'04" E 207.00 feet along said Block 1; Thence S 00°35'34" W 207.20 feet along said Block 1 to the point of beginning.
