Looping project to loop 12" water mains on lona Road east of Hitt Road to 12" line on Hitt Road south of lona Road. The project will also cross Highway 26 going west and connecting 12" line for Anderson Commercial Park (See attached map).

Using hydraulic modeling scenarios, it was determined that the best site for the system's next well will be in the Anderson Commercial Park. The well project is planned for 2020. To get the most out of the well, the looping on lona Road and Hitt Road is needed. The projected cost for the looping is \$934,200. This project will install approximately 6,400 linear feet of 12" water main and bores under two railroad crossings, an irrigation canal, and Highway 26 totaling approximate 450 linear feet.

The planned loop will provide an alternate route for water to flow from Well 8 (the closest well to the current dead end on Hitt Road) to the north of the railroad tracks. The land east of Hitt Road and south of the railroad tracks is currently gravel pits for a half a mile. No alternate route is feasible to cross the railroad tracks in that half mile. Current pressures during the summer months are usually in the 80 to 87 psi range. The project would help reduce the excess pressure in this area and push water to the northern part of the system where it is needed.

# MEDICAL EMERGENCY

Customers with outstanding balances, as of the billing date, will be charged a 1% per month late payment fee. The bills are calculated on water use between meter readings and are due by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month.

The one-time Hook-up Fee for newly constructed homes is \$500 for a % meter, \$600 for a 1" meter, \$930 for a 11/2" meter, and \$1,205 for a 2" meter.
