Summary of Rules and Regulations of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission Governing Customer Relations of Natural Gas, Electric, and Water Public Utilities.

A utility may terminate service to a customer without his/her permission after adequate notice for the following reasons:

- 1. Failure to pay an undisputed past due bill or abide by the terms of a payment arrangement.
- 2. Misrepresentation of identity for the purpose of obtaining service.
- 3. Denying or willfully preventing access to the meter or the utility easement or tampering with the meter.
- 4. Non sufficient funds check.
- 5. Willful waste of service.

A utility may deny or terminate service without prior notice to the customer or applicant and without his/her permission for one or more of the following reasons:

- 1. A situation exists that is immediately dangerous to life, physical safety or property.
- 2. The utility is ordered to terminate service by any court, the Commission or other authorized authority.
- 3. The service is obtained, diverted or used without the authorization or knowledge of the utility.
- 4. The utility has made a diligent attempt to notify customer of termination, but has been unable to make contact.

Late fees, Returned check fees and Notification of Termination

- 1. A billing will be considered past due at the next month's billing. A 1% late charge will be billed at that time based on the outstanding balance.
- 2. A \$ 20. fee will be charged for every returned check.
- 3. A written notice of termination must be mailed at least seven (7) days befor the proposed termination date.
- 4. At least twenty four(24) hours before the service is terminated, another attempt shall be made to contact the customer in person or by telephone.
- 5. If service is not terminated within twenty one (21) calendar days after the proposed termination date, another seven(7) day and twenty four(24) hour notice is required.
- 6. No additional notice is required if upon receipt of a termination notice the customer make a payment arrangement and fails to keep it, or when a payment is made with a returned check.

When Termination is not allowed.

- 1. The unpaid bill totals less than fifty dollars(\$50) or two (2) months service, whichever is less.
- 2. The unpaid bill is for service to another customer.
- 3. The unpaid bill results from the purchase of non-utility goods or services.

4. Terminations are not allowed on Friday, Saturday, Sunday, legal holidays, the day preceding legal holidays, or at any time when the company is not open for business.

Medical Emergency

If the customer or a member of the household is seriously ill or has a medical emergency, the utility will postpone termination of service for thirty(30) days if a written certificate signed by a licensed physician or public health official is received.

An informal or formal complaint concerning the termination may be filed directly with the utility. If the customer is dissatisfied with the proposed resolution of the complaint, they may contact the Consumer Assistance staff by mail at the Idaho Public Utilities Commission, PO Box 83720, Boise, ID 83720-0074, or by telephone at 800-432-0369, or online at http://www.puc.idaho.gov/.
